Second Sunday of October will be Homecoming and they have 146 responses so far. The Sanctuary just turned 150 years old. Reverend Millsaps has been the Lay Pastor for about two years.
  - Approval of Minutes of last meeting August 15, 2016. The minutes were approved as presented. Paula Wallace made the motion to accept the minutes with a second from Libby Sigmon.
  - Comments from secretary Gayla Woody. Participants were asked to sign in on the orange sheet.

## II. Presbytery News.

September 13 was the last day of service for Anita Bernhardt. On Sunday she began
and interim in Erie, Pennsylvania. The committee to hire her replacement has been
recommended and will come before exams in early October. His name is Billy
Robinson. He is married to Mary Elizabeth Robinson who is the minister at Black
Mountain. He will come before the October Presbytery for approval.

- Presbytery will host a Ministers Retreat at William Black Lodge at Montreat from September 26-28.
- The HOPE Campaign funds are coming in and being spent. Some have been spent on Camp Grier and some sent to Malawi and Guatemala. Churches should be acting on those pledges.
- Charles Davenport and Sylvia Sellars are commissioners to Synod. Third Street received some funding from Synod for which they applied. The next meeting is in March and will be at Massannetta Springs, Harrisburg, Virginia.
- Love's Chapel was informed that Presbytery website has a link to Synod to request funds.
- Synod Grants and Awards Committee has been looking at Peace-making to look for projects to fund. Perhaps GAP will consider looking at the application for consideration of a project.
- Next Presbytery meeting is at Brevard Davidson River in October.

# III. Other reports and items

- Habitat Update Bill Glover & Sue Johnson.
  - Bill reported that we got a very fast stop but the trusses did not arrive and work stopped abruptly. Trusses will not arrive until September 26. Nothing to do until they arrive. Walls are assembled and complete.
  - o Groundbreaking was well attended and went very well. It is a super family and ready to work. The recipient is a disabled veteran and is a very hard worker.
  - Additional donations are needed. We do not know how much money has been received through Run for the Money at this time.
  - At this time the schedule will not be adjusted until we actually receive the trusses.
     The weather and Cherryville's ability to do the shingles will bring some challenges in getting the build back on schedule.
  - Churches will be contacted as soon as the schedule has been adjusted.
  - Habitat has completed their Event Room. It would lend itself for GAP to host a fundraiser. They have new sound system, acoustics, offices, new flooring, side entrance, and improved parking.
- Guatemala Sue Johnson reported the Guatemala Partnership meeting will be November 6 at 2:00 at Belmont First. The Guatemala Partnership Director, Maria, has a new baby. They are home and the mother and baby are doing great. Guatemala at Easter will be an exceptional experience. It will be a great time to go.

• Christtrek at Belmont & West Ave. Paula reported that there was a meeting this afternoon for the first event on October 15 & 16 with the youth from Belmont First. Everyone is very excited.
